- We are praying for the remaining funds to come in so we can move forward with construction that would allow us to house 22 additional young ladies. At present, about 65% of the needed funds have been raised.
- We also have a vision to build an auditorium/lodge at Camp Rhino that would serve as housing for couples and provide a meeting space for around 300 people. Our plans include a 60' x 60' building that would be a tremendous tool for ministry, conferences, and retreats. Please pray with us for God's provision and direction in this project.
